For the examination the candidate should be asked to perform all of the following scales and arpeggios from memory. Play each scale and arpeggio tongued or slurred (as requested by the teacher)

Scales

- G major (two octaves)
- B major (one octave)
- G minor - harmonic (two octaves)
- F minor - melodic (one octave)

Arpeggios

- G major (two octaves)
- B major (one octave)
- G minor (two octaves)
- F minor (one octave)

Chromatic scale

- On G (two octaves)

Dominant 7th

- In C (two octaves)
